Compatibility & Intended Use

Salsa Backcountry grips are designed for mountain bike handlebars with a grip diameter of 22.2mm (7/8ths inch).

Tools

Hairspray

Spray Adhesive

Rubbing Alcohol

Installation Instructions

1. Clean the surface of the handlebar where the grips will go with rubbing alcohol.
2. Spray a small amount of hairspray or spray adhesive inside the grip and wrestle the grip all the way onto the bar.
⚠ WARNING: Do not ride the bike immediately after installing grips this way! The hairspray or spray adhesive will not have dried fully and the grips could slide off the bars resulting in a serious injury. Ideally, the hairspray or spray adhesive should be allowed to dry overnight just to be safe.
3. If, after drying, the grips still move or slide, remove them and repeat Step #2, allowing the grips to dry again overnight.

⚠ WARNING: handlebar ends should always be covered by grips or closed with an appropriate plug. In case of a fall or crash, an open handlebar end can cause a serious injury.

Ongoing Maintenance

⚠ WARNING: Periodically make sure that the grips do not slip or twist at all. Loose grips could slide off the bars resulting in a serious injury.

Warranty Information:

Proof of purchase is required before a warranty claim is processed. Salsa Cycles therefore strongly encourages warranty registration at salsacycles.com. Failure to register will not affect consumer rights, so long as the consumer can show in a reasonable manner proof of original ownership and the date the Salsa Cycles product was purchased.
