



## HOW TO IDENTIFY THE SERIAL NUMBER OF A SALSA CUTTHROAT CARBON DELUXE V2 AND CUTTHROAT CARBON V2 FORK

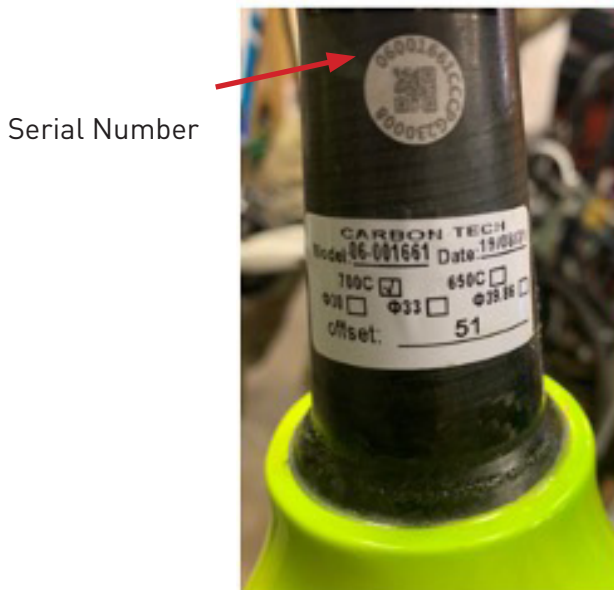
*This guide is for Salsa bicycle retailers.*

Every Salsa Cutthroat Carbon Deluxe V2 and Cutthroat Carbon V2 fork has a serial number imprinted on a circle located on its steerer tube and is only visible by partially removing the fork from the bicycle frame.

Every serial number is a QR code encircled by a sequence of alpha-numeric characters. Don't be distracted by other codes etched into the steerer tube, or other stickers affixed to the fork. The ONLY thing you are looking for is the alpha-numeric serial number that encircles the QR code.

Once you have located the serial number, look for the middle portion that contains either CCAP or CCCP. If the next character after P is G, then this Cutthroat fork might be defective and should not be used until further notice from Salsa. Only G forks are affected. Any character other than G means the fork is not part of the safety notice and voluntary recall and is therefore safe to use.
