## Compatibility and Intended Use

Salsa's Fender Mounts are compatible with the Colossal Ti and steel frames, and the Colossal and Vaya carbon forks. They provide a non-permanent fender mounting solution for wet weather riding.

In this set of conditions, contact with irregular terrain and loss of tire contact with the ground may occur. Drops are intended to be limited to 15cm (6") or less. <p>3 For rough off-road riding and jumps less than 24" (61cm)</p>	This is a set of conditions for operation of a bicycle that includes Condition 1 and Condition 2 as well as rough trails, rough unpaved roads, and rough terrain and unimproved trails that require technical skills. Jumps and drops are intended to be less than 61cm (24"). <p>4 For extreme off-road riding</p>	This is a set of conditions for operation of a bicycle that includes Conditions 1, 2, 3, and 4; downhill grades on rough trails at speeds less than 40 km/h (25 mph), or both. Jumps are intended to be less than 122cm (48").	Bend Handlebars Rustler Handlebars Salt Flat Handlebars
<p>5 For dirt jumping</p>	This is a set of conditions for operation of a bicycle that includes Conditions 1, 2, 3, and 4; extreme jumping; or downhill grades on rough trails at speeds in excess of 40 km/h (25 mph); or a combination thereof.	

## Tools:

8mm box end wrench

Torque wrench that measures in Nm

Blue threadlocker

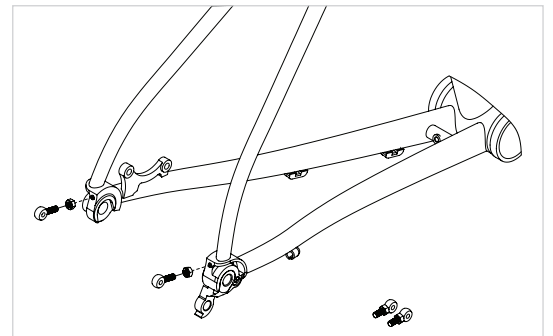
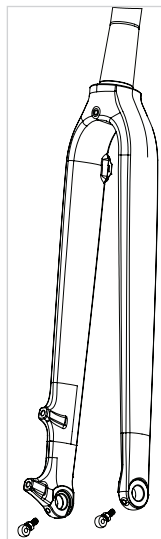
## Fork Installation

1. Remove set screws from fender mounting holes.
2. Apply Blue threadlocker onto fender mount.
3. Thread M5 nuts onto fender mounts.
4. Make sure the nuts are threaded onto the fender mounts at least 6 to 7 threads.
5. Thread fender mounts into fork leg fender-mounting holes.
6. Make sure fender mounts are threaded in at least 4 threads.
7. Thread nut up to the fork leg.
8. Make sure fender mount face is parallel with plane of frame and fork.
9. Tighten nut to 3–4Nm to lock fender mount into position.
10. Check assembly that it is properly tight.
11. Install fenders per fender manufacturer's specifications. (NOTE: Salsa recommends QR fenders only!)
12. An M5 screw will need to be used to mount fender crown hardware to fork.
13. Follow same instructions for rear fender mounting.

## Ongoing Maintenance

Periodically check to make sure all mounting bolts are properly tightened to the frame, and that the fenders are properly installed per the fender manufacturer's specifications.

**▲ WARNING:** Do not mount racks or any other load bearing accessory to the fender mounts. Doing so could result in fork breakage, causing a loss of control. If you are not sure if a device is compatible, consult your dealer.

This warranty applies to 2014 and newer model bicycles and covers only Salsa Cycles branded product. Any other original part or component shall be covered by the stated warranty of the original manufacturer. Any products not specifically included above are hereby omitted.

TO THE EXTENT NOT PROHIBITED BY LAW, THESE WARRANTIES ARE EXCLUSIVE AND THERE ARE NO OTHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS INCLUDING WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

For 2013 and older model bicycles and products, please consult your Owner's Manual or contact Salsa Cycles or your Salsa dealer for the applicable warranty information.

This warranty does not cover the following:

- Damage due to improper assembly or follow-up maintenance or lack of skill, competence, or experience of the user or assembler
- Products that have been modified, neglected, used in competition or for commercial purposes, misused or abused, involved in accidents or anything other than normal use
